JULY 2003—Meisha Merlin Publishing Inc. will be re-issuing the Sime~Gen novels by Jacqueline Lichtenberg and Jean Lorrh, in the omnibus format they have made famous.

The program starts with *The Unity Trilogy*, 3 novels written to form a Trilogy—*House of Zeor*, *Ambrov Keon*, and *Zelerod's Doom* which tells the story of the First Contract that stopped the war that tore civilization apart.

2004—the first new novel in the Sime~Gen Universe since 1986 will be Jean Lorrh's *To Kiss Or To Kill*.

2005—*Fort Freedom*—two nov-

els telling of the origin of the Channels—the people who can prevent the Kill.

2006—a new novel: *The Farris Channel* by Jacqueline Lichtenberg tells of the founding of the Legendary House of Zeor.

More coming after that.

In the decades the novels have been out of print, the fans have written millions of words of fiction—some fannovels are professional quality. They've created arts, crafts, and generated LARPS and online RPG scenarios galore.

The Discussion List thrives, and enthusiasm has only grown with time.
