1980 – Jean Lorrh co-authored then wrote her own Sime~Gen novels

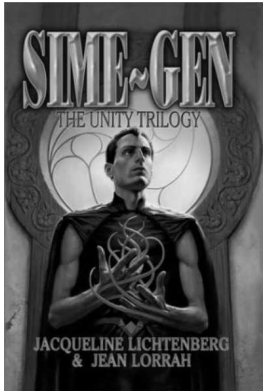
1999 – Authors incorporated and launched simegen.com to foster creativity

Having met in the early 1970's via Star Trek fandom, Jean Lorrh and Jacqueline Lichtenberg pursued separate writing careers until Jean was inspired to write stories in the Sime~Gen Universe.

Still producing novels separately, they developed a collaborative style that exemplified the core theme of Sime~Gen – that where diverse people mingle, creativity is released.

They were among the first writers bold enough to mix genres, bringing into sf and fantasy the complexities of the relationship driven novel, and trending away from the pure action style sf is known for.

This Intimate Adventure styling produced Lichtenberg's award winning Sime~Gen novel, *Unto Zeor, Forever* and eventually Jean Lorrh's award winning Vampire Romance, *Blood Will Tell*.
